Overview





We're a social enterprise that supports young people from under-represented backgrounds to develop the skills and experience they need to thrive in careers related to the policymaking process.

We work with hundreds of young people, each year, to increase their political knowledge and to raise awareness of the employment opportunities available in the political sphere.

Our mentoring scheme matches professionals in public affairs and public policy roles with young people from under-represented backgrounds who would benefit from gaining an insight into the career options available to them and support embarking on their careers.

- Hosted an event in Parliament to launch a report they write on tackling political inequality.

We have set-up a careers hub and provided 1:1 career-focused mentoring for over

200 university students.



What does it entail?



- It will run for 9 months, pairing mentees from disadvantaged backgrounds with mentors who work in public affairs, policy, PR and politics.
- The majority of the mentees are college and university students or recent graduates.
- We're looking for a range of mentors, from those earlier in their careers who are looking to develop their leadership and management skills, to those in leadership positions looking to give back.
- Training and ongoing personal development support are provided to mentors.
- You'll meet your mentee once per month and IHAV will provide you with resources and tools to structure the meetings.
- We also hold optional networking sessions with guest speakers.
